# **Psoriasis Cream**

#### MAIN INGREDIENTS AND THEIR ROLES:

*Taraxacum officinale -* Has anti-proliferative, anti-inflammatory and antioxidant effect.

Berberis vulgaris - Has anti-inflammatory properties that reduces redness in psoriatic flares.

Hamamelis virginica - Soothes the skin and maintains hydration.

*Indigo extract* - Reduces the inflammation, improves cell connections and prevents trans-epidermal water loss (TEWL).

Rubia cordifolia - Reduces pruritis, reduces psoriatic flare up and has anti-inflammatory, analgesic and antioxidant properties..

## **KEY INGREDIENTS**

Dandelion extract, Curcumin extract, Barberry extract, Witch hazel water extract, Manjishtha water extract, Indigo extract, Aloe vera extract, Coffee extract, Gotu Kola extract, Sesame oil, Almond oil, Honey, Hydroxystearic/Linolenic/Oleic Polyglycerides, Sodium Acrylate/Sodium Acryloyldimethyl Taurate Copolymer, Potassium sorbate, Caprylyl glocol, Phenethyl alcohol, propylene glycol, Sodium benzoate, Acetic acid, Polysorbate 80, Demineralised water and herbal green fragrance.



### **EFFICACY DATA - IN-VITRO**

Psoriasis is an inflammatory skin disease with abnormal proliferation (increase in the number) of keratinocytes. This results in formation of scales and itchy, dry and red patches. Inhibition of keratinocytes proliferation reflects the anti-psoriatic potential.
